On September 30, 2009, the Supreme Court granted a petition for a writ

of certiorari in the case *McDonald v. Chicago*, No. 08-1521, on the issue “whether the Second Amendment right to keep and bear arms is incorporated as against the States by the Fourteenth Amendment’s Privileges or Immunities or Due Process Clauses.” In addition, oral arguments took place on March 2, 2010.

Because the same issue before the Supreme Court in *McDonald v. Chicago* appears to be involved in four motions pending before this court (Doc. No.’s [62](#), [63](#), [64](#) & [71](#)), recommendations on these motions will be stayed pending the Supreme Court’s decision in *McDonald v. Chicago*.

Counsel for the parties are to notify the court, within ten (10) days of the Supreme Court’s decision in the *McDonald* case, as to whether they would like to submit supplemental briefs in light of that decision.
